Well, it's been a while since the Palouse Wine Tasters has had a tasting event, Nov. 14, 2019 to be exact. But we've all survived the pandemic and, hopefully, are now all fully vaccinated. So, it's time to get back to the things we really like to do—tasting some great wine!! And here's your opportunity—a great summer tasting of Alsatian whites featuring the wines of Domaine Weinbach

Domaine Weinbach lies just outside the Alsatian village of Kaysersberg. The property has been planted with vines since the 9th century and was established as a winery in 1612 by Capuchin friars. These vineyards, surrounded by ancient walls to this day, are specifically named Clos des Capucins. After being sold as national property during the French Revolution, it was acquired by the Faller brothers in 1898 who then left it to their son and nephew, Théo. Théo Faller, a prominent figure in Alsace winegrowing and wine production, developed, expanded, and enhanced the Domaine. After his death in 1979, his wife Colette, his daughters Catherine and Laurence, and their team continued the family's passion for and commitment to delivering excellence. Since 2016, Catherine has led the winery with her sons, Eddy and Théo.

We will be tasting a wide variety of Weinbach wines along with some similar non-Weinbach wines to provide contrast. Following a Riesling Sekt opener, the tasting will consist of 4 flights: 1) Pinot Blanc, Sylvaner, and Muscat 2) 3 Gewürztraminers 3) 3 Rieslings and 4) 3 Grand Cru Rieslings. Each flight will be accompanied by two foods—one rich and the other spicy. Although the servings will be small, I'm sure tasting 8 different dishes will not leave you hungry.

The event will be outdoors on our covered patio, so if the weather is cool or hot, dress appropriately. Also please bring your own service (plate, 2 small bowls, utensils). I'm looking forward to a great time and seeing you there.
