Oregon, while known for its stand out Willamette Valley Pinot Noirs, is host to several other growing regions and grape varietals that merit exploration. We will taste wines from the Columbia Valley and Walla Walla AVA's which extend beyond Washington into Oregon. Additionally, wine from the famed Willamette Valley and the new Southern Oregon AVA's (now gaining attention for their Rhône varietals) will be tasted. As the tasting will be blind, it should allow us to approach the regional variation within Oregon wines with an unprejudiced palate. We will begin with the Argyle Extended Tirage sparkling Brut (Willamette Valley AVA), go to Rieslings, then Pinot Noirs, followed by Syrahs and finish with a Zinfandel Port from Sineann (Columbia Valley AVA). Accompanying the wines will be delicious hand-tossed stone-baked pizzas.
